1/3 OF THE POPULATION OF GREECE LIVES IN ATTICA

The financial crisis has affected Greeks' personal and sexual life and has increased incidences of violence against women

- 47% incidents of physical, sexual and verbal violence in the last few months in Greece: Unemployed men with intense job stress, pressing financial obligations, low sexual activity are chiefly those who exert violence against their wives or girlfriends.
- Verbal abuse is at a rate of 72%, and financial blackmail comes second at 59%. Sexual humiliation follows at 55%; beatings are at a rate of 23% at 18%. In 8% of violence incidents, slight or serious injury was reported.
- Economic profile of men who used violence against their companions, 4 out of 10 were jobless, while 39% percent were in a bad financial situation. There is a rate of 17% of wealthy men who abused their companion.

Research of Hellenic Society for the Study of Human Sexuality (EMAS) and of Andrology Institute of Athens, based on 600 men and 400 women interviewed via telephone. Men between 35 - 45 years old comprise the research target group.

Safe household

- In the period from 11/3/2011 to 30/6/2013
- 3517 phone calls to the SOS line relating to complaints in cases of gender violence, in prefecture Attikis
- Of these 2877 calls, (81%) complaints were themselves abused women while 640 calls (18%) were complaints from third persons
- Of the 2877 complaints made by the same battered women
- 2426 calls (79%) were domestic violence
- 72 calls (3%) sexual harassment
- 36 calls (1%) rape
- 3 calls (0%) prostitution
- Call 1 (0%) trafficking
- 390 calls (14%) reported other forms of violence.
